- The 'Woman ICT Leader' being featured in your reel should be a national of the country where your college is located or from any of the ECTEL Contracting States, and you <u>MUST</u> have permission to use all images in your reel.

- The words *'...and that's why she is my ICT champion'* <u>MUST</u> be included in the reel.
